Guidelines for your stay on site:

- 1. Encounter other cultures with openness and interest differences in lifestyles or perceptions are an opportunity to discover new things.
- 2. See yourself as a learning guest. You are not a tourist, but rather supporting sustainable development in the Boabeng region.
- 3. Please respect and honor the customs and traditions, as well as the religion of the local people.
- 4. A respectful demeanor helps: Clothing, behavior in public, and interaction with the neighborhood/surroundings are signs of respect.
- 5. Integrate yourself into local structures and try to contribute as best you can.
- 6. If you are unable to attend the usual hours of 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. for health or other reasons, please notify Mr. Boadi in advance ideally before 7 a.m. so we can plan well.
- 7. You should also inform him in advance of any excursions or trips on weekends or during school holidays; he is your host and bears responsibility.

Furthermore:

- Take the time to integrate yourself into the daily routine of the project and village life. Visits are possible after prior arrangement with the project leader, Boadi just ask.
- Leisure activities are of course welcome, but are your own responsibility. Neither we, as the intermediary organizations, nor the onsite project management are responsible for the consequences of what you do in your free time outside of volunteer work. Financial Information:
- The $\ensuremath{\in} 300$ per month only covers accommodation and meals.

All other travel costs, as well as visas, vaccinations, international health insurance, pocket money, etc., are to be borne by the volunteer. – The total cost of $\in 300$ per month for the entire period must be transferred to the following account two weeks before the start of the trip:
